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**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

On June 4, 2008, Claimant's Counsel filed an Application for Formal Hearing (hereinafter "Claimant's Application") with the Office of Hearings and Adjudication, Administrative Hearings Division (hereinafter "AHD"), and on June 17, 2008, Employer/Carrier's Counsel filed an Application for Formal Hearing (hereinafter "Employer/Carrier's Application") with AHD. A Scheduling Order issued on June 13, 2008. Pursuant to paragraph 2 of the Scheduling Order,


The completed [Joint Pre-Hearing Statement] and [Stipulation Form] shall be jointly executed and submitted to the [Administrative Hearing Division/Office of Hearings and Adjudications] by the party requesting the hearing on or before July 21, 2008.


No Joint Pre-Hearing Statement or Stipulation Form has been filed by either party; therefore, on or before the close of business on August 26, 2008, the parties hereby are **ORDERED TO SHOW CAUSE** why both Claimant's Application and Employer/Carrier's Application should not be dismissed. The parties further are **ORDERED** to properly file a Joint Pre-Hearing Statement and Stipulation Form no later than the close of business on August 26, 2008; submission by facsimile is not proper filing. Nothing contained in this Order extends the discovery cutoff or deadline dates as contained in the Scheduling Order.

In the event Claimant complies with this Show Cause Order and Employer/Carrier does not comply with this Show Cause Order, should this matter proceed to a formal hearing, Employer/Carrier's Application shall be dismissed and Employer/Carrier shall be precluded from submitting documentary evidence at the formal hearing. In the event Employer/Carrier complies with this Show Cause Order and Claimant does not comply with this Show Cause Order, Claimant's Application shall be dismissed, and Claimant shall be precluded from submitting documentary evidence at the formal

hearing. If neither party complies with this Show Cause Order, Claimant's Application and Employer/Carrier's Application shall be dismissed.
