ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On May 5, 2008, the Administrative Hearings Division (hereinafter, AHD) received from Kirk D. Williams, Esquire, as counsel for Janell T. Perry, claimant herein, a Petition for Attorneys' Fee. Counsel has requested an award of an attorney's fee in the amount of \$2,250.00, representing 11.25 hours of service to be paid by the claimant for services rendered before this body. In support of the petition, Counsel has provided an Itemization of Time and Services.

Claimant is hereby **ORDERED** to show cause why an Order should not issue from this body awarding an attorney's fee to claimant's counsel pursuant to the Act. Claimant's response to this Order must be filed on or before **June 18, 2008**, with a copy served upon counsel. Upon timely receipt of claimant's response, an Order will be entered pursuant to the Act. Failure to timely respond will likewise result in the issuance of an Order to show cause why counsel should not be awarded an attorney's fee.
