

ORDER

On or about March 13, 2000, the Office of Hearings and Adjudication/Administrative Hearings Division (hereinafter, AHD) received from Eric May, Esquire, as counsel for Stephen Onyebuchi, claimant herein, an Application for Formal Hearing (AFH) on the issues of temporary partial disability benefits, average weekly wage and bad faith. Pursuant thereto, a formal hearing was scheduled to convene before Administrative Law Judge Leslie Meek on May 7, 2008.

On May 2, 2008, AHD received correspondence from Claimant, through Counsel, that the parties have resolved the outstanding issues in the case and that Claimant withdraws the AFH with the consent of Howard University Hospital/Sedgwick CMS, Inc. and without prejudice. In light of the foregoing, the AFH herein is hereby **dismissed without prejudice** and the matter is **remanded** to the Office of Worker's Compensation for such further action, if any, as may be warranted.
