**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

On September 30, 2008, the Administrative Hearings Division (hereinafter, AHD) received from Benjamin T. Boscolo, Esquire, as counsel for Claimant (hereinafter, counsel), a Petition for an Order pursuant to §31 of the Act, D.C. Code Ann. §32-1530. Therein, Counsel requested an assessment of an attorney's fee in the above captioned matter. In support of said Petition, counsel has filed computations of the time spent thereon, for the services rendered before this forum, for a fee of \$5,838.41, and costs in the amount of \$903.61 based upon 45.55 hours of work performed before AHD.

Counsel shall ascertain whether Employer will consent to the fees sought consistent with the requirements set forth in D.C. Superior Court Rules- Civil Rule 12-I (2006). Absent consent, Employer shall file its objections to Counsel's Petition within fifteen (15) business days of service of this Order. Upon timely receipt of Employer's response, an Order will be entered pursuant to the Act. Failure to timely respond will likewise result in the issuance of an Order.
