

**ORDER**

On consideration of the petitions for review filed in Appeal No. 16-AA-759 and Appeal No. 16-AA-808 that both seek review of a Compensation Review Board decision and order remanding the compensation order to the administrative hearings division for further action; this court's orders dated August 12 and September 12, 2016, that, *inter alia*, directed petitioners to show cause why the court should not dismiss the petitions for review as having been taken from a non-final order; and petitioner's response in Appeal No. 16-AA-759; and it appearing no response has been filed in Appeal No. 16-AA-808; it is

ORDERED that the petitions for review are hereby dismissed as having been taken from a non-final order. *See Warner v. District of Columbia Dep't of Emp't Servs.*, 587 A.2d 1091, 1093 (D.C. 1991) ("Ordinarily an order remanding the case to an administrative agency is not a final order." (citations omitted)); *Washington Hosp. Ctr. v. District of Columbia Dep't of Emp't Servs.*, 712 A.2d 1018, 1020 (D.C. 1998) (finding this court lacked jurisdiction to review the merits of a petition when the case was remanded for further findings of fact and conclusions of law).
