**ORDER DISMISSING NOVEMBER 8, 2016 FEE APPLICATION**

This matter is before the Compensation Review Board on a "Fee Petition" filed on November 8, 2016 by Claimant's counsel, Harold L. Levi.

On July 14, 2016, Employer filed an Application for Review with the CRB appealing a Compensation Order issued by the Department of Employment Services Administrative Hearings Division ("AHD"). On November 3, 2016, the CRB issued a Decision and Partial Remand Order.

The CRB Decision and Partial Remand Order is not a final order as the CRB has directed AHD to issue a Compensation Order on Remand. The Compensation Order on Remand will become final 30 days after issuance if neither party files a timely appeal. Because the Decision and Partial Remand Order issued by the CRB on November 3, 2016 was not final when Claimant's counsel filed the November 8, 2016 Fee Application, the Fee Application is dismissed without prejudice.
