

ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION FOR REVIEW

This case is before the Compensation Review Board (CRB) on Claimant's August 19, 2015 Application for Review (AFR) appealing a Compensation Order issued by the Administrative Hearings Division on July 20, 2015.

On November 9, 2015, the parties filed with the CRB a Joint Motion to Stay the Application for Review Pending Settlement, stating that the parties settled the claim on appeal, and requesting these proceedings be stayed or dismissed without prejudice to the right of either party to request reinstatement if an order approving the proposed settlement is not entered by the Office of Workers' Compensation (OWC).

The Joint Motion is hereby granted Claimant's August 19, 2015 AFR is dismissed, without prejudice, subject to the right of either party to request its reinstatement within 30 days from the date of issuance of an order by OWC related to the parties' settlement agreement.
