REMAND ORDER

On August 6, 2014, the District of Columbia Court of Appeals (DCCA) issued an Order in this case in which the Court held it is:

FURTHER ORDERED that [Employer's] motion to remand is granted and this case is hereby remanded to the agency for further proceedings consistent with the statements made in [Employer's] motion.

Employer's motion identified in the Order stated in pertinent part:

The District of Columbia Department of Employment Services ("DOES"), after consideration of petitioner's arguments on appeal, agrees with petitioner's first argument—*i.e.*, that the Administrative Hearings Division ("AHD") of DOES committed legal error by making a finding concerning petitioner's permanent disability status where the Office of Risk Management's Public Service Worker's Compensation Program ("PSWCP") had not made an initial administrative determination on this issue.

A review of the AHD decision shows the AHD Compensation Order ("CO") stated the "Claim For Relief" was "Claimant seeks temporary total disability benefits from the date of termination to the present and continuing." The CO also identified the "Issue" to be decided was "Has there

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been a change in Claimant [sic] medical condition to support termination of temporary total disability benefits?"

However, in addition to making findings with respect to the temporary total disability claim, the CO made findings with respect to whether Claimant proved permanent disability status - a matter for which PSWCP had not made an initial administrative determination and which was not before AHD.

Therefore, this case is remanded to AHD for further consideration consistent with the DCCA's August 12, 2014 Order.
