D.C. Labor Market Indicators: September 2017

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Highlights


- From January 2015 to September 2017:
 - The unemployment rate in DC decreased by 1.0 percentage points (or 13.3% decrease);
 - Unemployment rate in Ward 7 and Ward 8 decreased by 0.9 percentage points (7.0% decrease) and 1.2 percentage points (7.5% decrease) respectively;
 - Total number of DC residents that are employed increased by 20,200;
 - Total number of jobs in DC increased by 34,000;
 - Initial monthly unemployment insurance benefits claimants decreased by 32.40%;
 - Total number of unemployed DC residents decreased by 2,300 people;
 - In DC there are 1.6 jobs available (advertised) for 1 unemployed DC resident;
 - The average weekly median duration of unemployment for Black and African American decreased by 19 weeks;
 - The private sector total number of payroll jobs in the District increased by 31,600 new jobs or 6.08% increase from January 2015;
 - Leisure and Hospitality has the highest employment increase by industry with 10,500 since January 2015;
 - The highest in-demand occupation is Computer Occupations, All Other; with an average monthly opening of 1,871;
 - The highest in-demand occupation requiring less than a bachelor's degree is Computer User Support Specialists; with an average monthly opening of 1,047.






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The District's Monthly Unemployment Rate: Jan. 2015 - Sept. 2017






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
Unemployment Rate by Ward (January 2015 - September 2017)





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
Unemployment Rate by Ward: September 2017





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
Total Number of Jobs and Total Private Sector Jobs in DC (Jan. 2015 - Sept. 2017)





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
Total Employment and Private Sector Employment in D.C. (Jan.2015 - Sept. 2017) (In Thousands)





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
Employed D.C. Residents (Jan. 2015 -Sept. 2017) (In Thousands)





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
Median Duration of Unemployment (Jan. 2015 – Sept. 2017)





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
Top 5 Industry with Highest Employment Increase (Jan. 2015 – Sept. 2017)





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
Job Openings vs. Number of Unemployed DC Residents (Jan. 2015 -Sept. 2017)





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
Top 5 Job Openings: January 2015 - September 2017 (Average Monthly Unique Job Postings)
