Industries for which data are confidential are not shown. Some non-confidential data are also not included if they can be used to derive confidential data within an industry or sector. NAICS is North American Industry Classification Code. See apendix for more information on NAICS.

In some cases wages are affected by seasonal changes in business activity, the number of weeks or hours worked, if pay periods are greater or less than usual, and if extra compensation is given in the form of bonuses, profits distributed, or other unidentified lump-sum payments.
