NEXT STEPS

To maintain your spot within the 2013 Mayor Vincent C. Gray's One City Summer Youth Employment Program, make sure you follow these four steps prior to the start date of the program.

Please note: Emails will be sent regarding each step with additional information on deadlines, locations, and other important instructions.

STEP 1:	The SYEP Youth Portal allows you to check the status of your application, your personal information, view important messages about the program, and more!
Master the SYEP Youth	To log into your SYEP Youth Portal, please visit www.summerjobs.dc.gov and click the 'Youth Information' button. You will need to use the email address and password you provided when you applied.

STEP 2:

Complete a resume and upload it in your SYEP Youth Portal! A resume is an important document that tells employers about your experience, education, and skills. It also helps us to identify a summer job that best matches your interests.

In order to receive a summer job, all youth who are between the ages of 16-21 are required to submit a resume by no later than **Saturday, April 6, 2013**.

Youth who are between the ages of 14-15 are also strongly encouraged to complete a resume, but are not required to do so to maintain their seat in SYEP.

How to submit your resume ...

- 1. Create your resume using the Resume-Builder Tool available in the SYEP Youth Portal. This tool walks you through the process of creating a resume;
- 2. Upload a resume you have already created to the SYEP Youth Portal; or
- 3. Attend one of our resume workshops.

Never worked before? Don't think you have enough job experience to create a resume? Not true! Attend a resume workshop where you can learn how to include volunteer experience, community service, and extra-curricular activities that you have done or are currently involved in to your resume.

STEP 4: Attend a mandatory orientation session. You will be invited to attend an orientation session. These sessions will be taking place on evenings and weekends beginning in March and ending in June.
