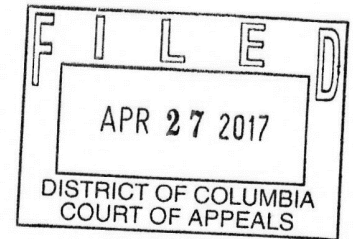

**ORDER**

On consideration of the petition and cross-petition for review; this court's March 15, 2017, and March 30, 2017, orders directing petitioner and cross-petitioner to show cause why their respective petitions for review should not be dismissed as having been taken from a non-final order; the motion for an extension of time to file a response filed by the District of Columbia Public Schools ("DCPS") in Appeal No. 17-AA-222 and its consent motion to voluntarily dismiss Appeal No. 17-AA-222; intervenor Marsha Karim's motion to dismiss Appeal No. 17-AA-222 as having been taken from a non-final order; and cross-petitioner Marsha Karim's response in Appeal No. 17-AA-287, which the court construes as a motion to voluntarily dismiss Appeal No. 17-AA-287; and it appearing intervenor/cross-petitioner Marsha Karim requests this court to issue a published order on the jurisdictional issue presented in the orders to show cause; it is

ORDERED, *sua sponte*, that Appeal No. 17-AA-222 and 17-AA-287 are hereby consolidated. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the consent motion filed by DCPS to voluntarily dismiss Appeal No. 17-AA-222 is granted. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that Karim's motion to voluntarily dismiss Appeal No. 17-AA-287 is granted. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the dismissals are without prejudice to filing, if necessary, a new petition for review once a final order, including interest calculations is entered. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that Karim's motion to dismiss Appeal No. 17-AA-222 is denied as moot. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that DCPS's motion for an extension of time to file a response to this court's order to show cause in Appeal No. 17-AA-222 is denied as moot. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that Karim's request for a published order is denied.
