ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION FOR REVIEW

This case is before the Compensation Review Board (CRB) on Employer's March 6, 2015 Application for Review (AFR) appealing a Compensation Order issued on February 5, 2015.

On April 8, 2015, Employer filed a consent motion to withdraw its AFR stating that the parties have resolved all issues on appeal, and this matter should be remanded to the Office of Workers' Compensation for further proceedings.

Therefore, Employer's March 6, 2015 AFR is hereby dismissed without prejudice, subject to the right of either party to request its reinstatement within 30 days from the issuance of an Order from the Office of Workers' Compensation (OWC).

This matter is remanded to OWC for further proceedings.
