COME PREPARED- Make sure to have a pen, notebook, or any prepared materials that may be necessary for recruitment.

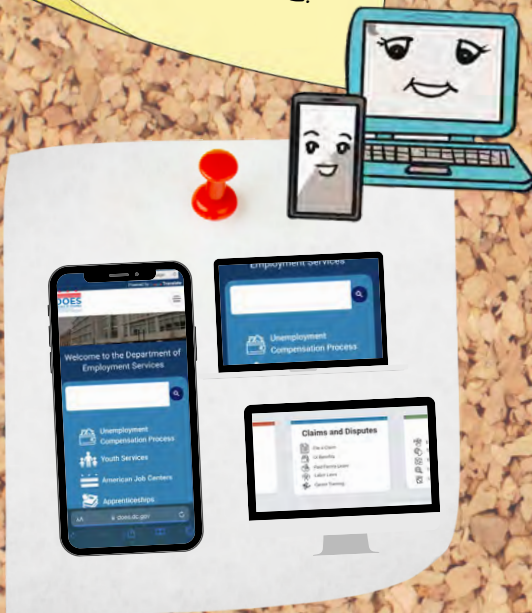
