

OCHSIP Program Information - For Hosts

The DC Department of Human Resources (DCHR) and the DC Department of Employment Services (DOES) is pleased to announce that we are now accepting proposals from District and Federal Government agencies that are interested in hosting a **One City High School Internship Program (OCHSIP)** student. This is the second year of the partnering of DCHR and DOES to support a program designed to attract and retain a future generation of District Government employees.

The OCHSIP is a staff-to-student supervisory/mentoring program that provides career development and employment opportunities for young emerging leaders. This year's program will still be for selected qualified 11th and 12th grade students, but for the first time DC Charter schools, alongside DC Public schools, will be included in the intern recruitment process. The Agency partnership has also allowed the program to expand from twenty (20) interns to a maximum of one hundred (100), with the hopes of serving more District youth. As the OCHSIP continues to thrive, DCHR and DOES invites you to become a valued partner in this highly sought after program.

The FY13 program is scheduled to begin April 22, 2013 and end August 9, 2013. The priority deadline to submit your agency's or schools proposal is **Friday, March 15, 2013**. Regular applications are due on **Friday, March 22, 2013**.
