Order Dismissing Application for Review

This case is before the Compensation Review Board (CRB) on the September 7, 2011 Application for Review (AFR) appealing a Compensation Order on Remand issued on August 9, 2011 by the Hearings and Adjudication section of the D.C. Department of Employment Services.

On September 19, 2012 claimant's counsel filed with the CRB a Consent Motion to Stay Appellate Proceedings, stating that the parties have proposed the settlement of all pending issues and requesting the CRB stay the appeal pending approval by the Office of Workers' Compensation of a settlement agreement.

Therefore, the claimant's September 7, 2011 AFR is dismissed without prejudice to the right of the claimant to request to the CRB for reinstatement within 20 days of an order issued by the Office of Workers' Compensation denying the proposed settlement.
