ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION FOR REVIEW

This case is before the Compensation Review Board (CRB) on the Employer and Insurer-Petitioner (Petitioners') July 5, 2012 Application for Review (AFR) of a Compensation Order on Remand issued on June 8, 2012 by the Hearings and Adjudication section of the D.C. Department of Employment Services.

On September 25, 2012 a "Motion to Stay Proceedings Pending Before the Compensation Review Board," signed by counsel for both parties, was filed with the CRB. That motion stated the parties have proposed the settlement of all pending issues and requested the CRB stay the appeal in this case pending approval of a proposed settlement agreement.

Therefore, the Petitioners' July 5, 2012 AFR is dismissed without prejudice to the right for the Petitioner to request that the CRB reinstate the AFR, filed within 20 days of an order issued by the Office of Workers' Compensation denying the proposed settlement.
